- 2. Essays must be double spaced with the pages numbered and printed single side. All text must be 12 pt. font and Times New Roman is preferred.
- 3. Cite any sources used.
- 4. Please do not include artwork, pictures, or plastic covers.
- 5. Participant must be a resident of Johnson County, IA
- 6. Include a cover sheet that includes the following: full name, full mailing address, phone number, student's grade level, school/homeschool, student's date of birth, parent's name & email (College Division excluded) and word count. Do not include names or any other form of identification on the actual essay.

Judging will be based on the following criteria

- 1. Content and clarity
- 2. Creativity and originality
- 3. Grammar, spelling, and organization.
